



Joe Mitchell - Redevelopment Authority Director/Assistant Public Works Superintendent Mitchell talked about the police department grant application. Mayor Walsh stated that Sandy & DuBois Police Departments have applied for a \$900.000+ grant to update various items in the departments. Mitchell stated that the grant would be used for Body Cam, Fixed Cameras, License Plate Readers, Records Management, Scanning Old Documents and Tasers. He went on to say that they are trying to move quickly because the funds are leftover COVID money. Mayor Walsh just wanted to highlight that the two communities are working together.
