

COUNCIL BILL NO. 1687INTRODUCED BY NANCY MICKSORDINANCE NO. 1599

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DUBOIS AMENDING CHAPTER 21, PART 6 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF DUBOIS TO PROVIDE FOR RESPONSIBILITY FOR REMOVAL OF ANTI-SKID MATERIAL AND RESTRICTING THE DEPOSITING OF GRASS CLIPPINGS, LEAVES AND DEBRIS IN AND UPON CITY STREETS AND THOROUGHFARES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of DuBois in Council assembled:

**Section 1.** Chapter 21, Part 6, Section 605 imposing penalties is hereby repealed and the following provisions adopted as Section 605:

Section 605: Responsibility for Removal of Anti-Skid Material from Sidewalks. Every person in charge or control of any building or lot of land fronting or abutting on a paved sidewalk, whether as owner, tenant, occupant, lessee, or otherwise, shall remove and clear away or cause to be removed or cleared away all anti-skid material that has accumulated on so much of said sidewalk as is in front of or abuts on said building or lot of land, on or before May 15<sup>th</sup> of each year.

**Section 2.** Chapter 21, Part 6 is hereby amended by the addition of the following as Section 606 thereof:

Section 606. Befouling of Streets Unlawful. It shall be unlawful to scatter, spill, dump or drop, or permit to be scattered, spilled, dumped or dropped, any soil, sand, stone, dirt, grass clippings, leaves, debris, refuse, litter, or other substance of any kind, including liquids and chemicals, upon streets, alleys and thoroughfares.

**Section 3.** Chapter 21, Part 6 is hereby amended by the addition of the following as Section 607 thereof.


Section 607. Penalties. Any person who shall violate any provision of this Part shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than six hundred (\$600.00) dollars plus costs, and in default of payment of said fine and costs, to imprisonment for a term not to exceed thirty (30) days. Each day that a violation continues shall constitute a separate offense hereunder.


**Section 4.** All other provisions of Chapter 21, Part 6 are hereby re-ratified and reaffirmed as if the same were set forth at length herein. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
