2nd Public Hearing - Debt Ordinance

City Solicitor Cherry felt this item was added in error that it should have stated Second and Final Reading of Council Bill No. 1967. Engineer Nasuti stated that as Cherry was on vacation last week we were unclear as to whether or not a date for a 2nd Public Hearing for the Debt Ordinance needed to be set. Cherry stated that no second hearing is needed, but after the Second and Final Reading of Council Bill No. 1967 she will have to re-advertise.

Due to time restrictions a request was made to add Second and Final Reading of Council Bill No. 1967 to this evenings agenda.

The motion was made by Gabriel and seconded by Bernardo that Council approve adding the Second and Final Reading of Council Bill No. 1967 to the evenings agenda. Roll call vote was as follows: Aughenbaugh, yea; Bernardo, yea; Gabriel, yea; Walsh, yea. Motion passed 4-0.

Second and Final Reading of Council Bill No. 1967

An Ordinance authorizing the incurring of nonelectorial debt by the City of DuBois through the issuance of a General Obligation Bond in the aggregate principal amount of not more than eighty-six million one hundred seventeen thousand eight hundred ninety-seven dollars (\$86,117,897.00) for the cost of the construction of a new 5.4 MGD AADF Water Resource Recovery Facility, consisting of a new influent pump station, septage receiving, screening, grit removal, SBR Biological Treatment, Tertiary Filtration, Ultraviolet (UV) Disinfection, Aerobic Digestion, Sludge Dewatering, Administrative Building, as well as a new access road and bridge to the site; together with the replacement of 8,000 feet of sanitary sewer and 4,500 feet of sewer interceptor and the rehabilitation of 1,600 feet of sewer interceptor with the ultimate demolition of the existing Waste Water Facility; covenanting to pay, and pledging unlimited taxing power for the payment of, the bond; establishing a sinking fund and appointing a sinking fund depository; fixing the form, interest rates, maturity, redemption and other provisions for the payment thereof; accepting a proposal for the purchase of the bond; authorizing a filing of required documents with the Department of Community and Economic Development; ratifying and directing certain actions of officers; and making certain other covenants and provisions in respect of the bond was presented for second and final reading. The motion was made by Gabriel and seconded by Bernardo that Council approve the Second and Final Reading of Council Bill No. 1967 as presented by City Solicitor Toni Cherry and it become Ordinance No. 1868 in the Code of Ordinance for the City of DuBois. Roll call vote was as follows: Aughenbaugh, yea; Bernardo, yea; Gabriel, yea; Walsh, yea. Motion passed 4-0.
