ORDINANCE NO. 1641

AN ORDINANCE

Levying and assessing the taxes of the City of DuBois for the year 2002 for General (City) Fund purposes, the Bond Sinking Fund, for the maintenance of the DuBois Public Library and for the DuBois Recreation Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the City of DuBois in Council assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by Authority of the same.

Section 1. A tax of Ninety-Five mills is hereby levied and assessed against all taxable land and a tax of Four and One Half mills is hereby levied against all taxable buildings and improvements in the City of DuBois for the year 2002, to be used for General (City) Fund purposes, for the Bond Sinking Fund, for the maintenance of the DuBois Public Library Fund, and for the Recreation Fund.

Section 2. The rate of taxation is Nine Dollars and Fifty Cents on each One Hundred Dollars of assessed valuation of taxable land use and Forty-Five Cents (.45) on each One Hundred Dollars of assessed valuation of taxable buildings and improvements.

Section 3. A tax of three and one-half mills is hereby levied and assessed against the total real estate valuation in the City of DuBois for the year 2002, to be used for General (City) Fund purposes, for the maintenance of the DuBois Public Library Fund, and for the Recreation Fund.

Section 4. The duplicate upon the said taxes shall be assessed for the year 2002 as prepared and submitted by the Board of Assessment and Revision of Taxes of Clearfield County, shall be placed in the hands of the City Treasurer for the year 2002, as provided by law.


Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
