## AN ORDINANCE

# AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DUBOIS AMENDING CHAPTER 15, PART II, SECTION 207.1. OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF DUBOIS TO REMOVE ORANGE ALLEY FROM WEST WASHINGTON AVENUE TO WEST WEBER AVENUE AS A ONE-WAY STREET AND TO REINSTATE THE SAME AS A TWO-WAY STREET IN THE AREA SO DESIGNATED.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the City of DuBois, in Council assembled, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 15, Part II, Section 207.1. of the Code of Ordinances of the City of DuBois is hereby amended to delete the street known as Orange Alley from West Washington Avenue to West Weber Avenue from the list of one-way streets.

SECTION 2. That Orange Alley from West Washington Avenue to West Weber Avenue shall be returned to its former designation as a two-way street.

SECTION 3. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. All other provisions of Chapter 15, Part II, Section 207 not in conflict herewith are hereby re-ratified and re-affirmed.
