## ORDINANCE NO. 1658

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DUBOIS AMENDING CHAPTER 21 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF DUBOIS BY ADDING TO PART 15, A SECTION VACATING AN UNOPENED 16-FOOT ALLEY EXTENDING FROM THE NORTHERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF KUNTZ STREET TO A SIX-FOOT WIDE CONCRETE SIDEWALK ADJACENT TO THE B&P RAILROAD 60-FOOT RIGHT-OF-WAY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of DuBois in Council assembled.

**Section 1.** That an unopened 16-foot alley located perpendicular to the right-of-way for Kuntz Street and extending in a northwesterly direction to a six-foot wide concrete sidewalk adjacent to the B&P Railroad right-of-way is hereby declared vacated. Said unopened 16-foot alley is described as follows:


BEGINNING at a point at the northeast corner of Lot No. 20, and being the lot now or formerly owned by Andrew Prontock by deed of Joseph L. Borrelli, Jr., dated April 23, 1971, and recorded in the Offices of Register and Recorder of Deeds of Clearfield County in Deed Book Vol. 581, page 453; thence North 14° 12' 00" West 31.76 feet to a point; thence South 44° 27' 00" East along lands now of formerly of Prontock to the northern boundary line of the right-of-way for Kuntz Street; thence in a westerly direction along the northern boundary line or Kuntz Street a distance of 16 feet, more or less, to a point; thence North 44° 27' 00" West along Lots 16, 17, 18, 19 and 20 to a point at the northern corner of Lot 20 and the place of beginning. BEING the right-of-way for a 16-foot unopened alley shown on the maps of the City of DuBois.

Ordained and enacted by the City Council of the City of DuBois in lawful session assembled this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of December, 2002.
