ORDINANCE NO. 1702

AN ORDINANCE

OF THE CITY OF DUBOIS AMENDING CHAPTER 10, PART II, SECTION 201 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF DUBOIS TO CORRECT TYPOGRAPHICAL ERRORS THEREIN AND TO AMEND THE HEIGHT LIMIT FOR VEGETATIVE GROWTH FROM 12 INCHES TO 6 INCHES.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the City of DuBois, in Council assembled, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 10, Part II, Section 201.1. of the Code of Ordinances of the City of DuBois is hereby amended to read as follows:

1. No person, firm or corporation, owning or occupying any property within the City of DuBois shall permit any grass or weeds or any vegetation whatsoever, not edible or planted for some useful or ornamental purpose, to grow or remain upon such premises so as to exceed a height of six (6) inches; nor shall any noxious weeds prohibited by the Noxious Weed Control Law (3 P.S. §255.8) or by regulations of the Department of Agriculture be permitted to grow within the City including, but not limited to:
 - A. Cannabis sativa, commonly known as marihuana
 - B. Cirsium arvense, commonly known as Canadian thistle
 - C. Rosa multiflora, commonly known as multiflora rose
 - D. Sorghum halepense, commonly known as Johnson grass
 - E. Chicory, Succory or Blue Daisy

Section 2. All other portions of Chapter 10, Part II are hereby reaffirmed and re-ratified insofar as the same are not in conflict herewith.

Section 3. All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances or Resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are herewith repealed.

Section 4. The within Ordinance shall be effective upon final enactment hereof.
