ORDINANCE NO. 1714

AN ORDINANCE

**OF THE CITY OF DUBOIS AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF DUBOIS TO DESIGNATE THE ROADWAY BETWEEN EAST DUBOIS AVENUE AND ORIENT AVENUE AS BENGHAUSER AVENUE.**

**WHEREAS**, Albert Benghauser will be honored by friends and relatives on the occasion of his 102<sup>nd</sup> birthday on June 14, 2007; and

**WHEREAS**, he was born in New York City, New York, on June 14, 1905, and has been a resident of this community since 1906; and

**WHEREAS**, during a long and productive lifetime, he was employed as a newspaper delivery boy; worked many years at the B&O Locomotive Works and prior to his retirement, served as a custodian at the DuBois Area High School and DuBois Business College; and

**WHEREAS**, he has lived during the most eventful century of this world's history and was a stabilizing influence on those around him during the turbulent years; and

**WHEREAS**, he has been a member of the Volunteer Fire Department since at least 1936, possibly longer.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IN RECOGNITION OF THE CONTRIBUTIONS MADE BY ALBERT BENGHAUSER DURING HIS LIFETIME, THE CITY OF DUBOIS DOES HEREBY DESIGNATE AND NAME THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED ROADWAY AS BENGHAUSER AVENUE:**

BEGINNING at a point which is the Northwest corner of Lot #5415; thence Northeast 31.4 feet ML to a point which is the Southwest corner of Lot #5413; thence Southeast 350 feet ML to a point which is the Southeast corner of Lot #5408; thence Southwest 31.4 feet ML to a point which is the Northeast corner of Lot #5419; thence Northwest 350 feet ML to a point at the Northwest corner of Lot #5413 and place of beginning.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment.
