ORDINANCE NO. 1748

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DUBOIS AMENDING CHAPTER 21 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF DUBOIS BY ADDING TO PART 15, A SECTION VACATING AN UNOPENED 16- FOOT ALLEY EXTENDING FROM THE NORTHEASTERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF OLIVE AVENUE TO THE SOUTHWESTERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF LUTHER AVENUE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of DuBois in Council assembled:

Section 1. That an unopened 16-foot alley located perpendicular to the right-of-way for Olive Avenue and extending in a northeasterly direction to the right-of-way for Luther Avenue is hereby declared vacated. Said unopened 16-foot alley is described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the northeasterly right-of-way of Olive Avenue, said point also being at the southeast corner of the premises known as 117 Olive Avenue and being described on the assessment maps of the County of Clearfield and the City of DuBois as Parcel No. 007-4-3-745; thence in a northeasterly direction along the boundary line of the foregoing lot and the northwestern line of the unopened 16-foot alley know as McCluskey Alley a distance of 172 feet to the southwestern right-of-way line of Luther Avenue; thence in a southeasterly direction along the right-of-way line of Luther Avenue a distance of 16 feet to the northwestern corner of the premises known as 119 Olive Avenue that is shown on the assessment maps of the County of Clearfield and the City of DuBois as Parcel No.007-4-3-744; thence along the northwestern boundary of Parcel No. 007-4-3-744 in a southwesterly direction of distance of 171.5 feet to the northeastern right-of-way line of Olive Avenue and the southwestern corner of the foregoing lot; thence in a northwesterly direction along the right-of-way line of Olive Avenue a distance of 16 feet to a point and the place of beginning. BEING the right-of-way for a 16-foot unopened alley designated on the maps of the City of DuBois as McCluskey Alley.
