

COUNCIL BILL NO. 1930**INTRODUCED BY: Edward Walsh****ORDINANCE NO.: 1830****AN ORDINANCE**

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1826 OF THE CITY OF DUBOIS THAT AUTHORIZED THE INCURRING OF NONELECTORAL DEBT BY THE ISSUANCE OF A GENERAL OBLIGATION NOTE IN THE AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF NOT MORE THAN EIGHT MILLION SIX HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$8,600,000.00) TO ADD A PARAGRAPH SPECIFICALLY DETAILING THE USEFUL LIFE OF EACH OF THE PROJECTS TO BE FUNDED BY SUCH NONELECTORAL DEBT.

WHEREAS, the Members of Council (the "Governing Body") of the City of DuBois (the "Local Government Unit") deemed it advisable to incur nonelectoral indebtedness, pursuant to the Local Government Unit Debt Act (the "Act"), for the funding of various capital projects and the construction of various improvements for the benefit of the citizens of the City of DuBois and, as a result, did enact Ordinance No. 1826 authorizing the incurring of nonelectoral debt but the language of said Ordinance did not contain a list of each project with a specific notation of the estimated useful life of each project to be funded as required under the Local Government Unit Debt Act at 53 Pa. C.S.A. §§8103(a)(1)(i) and 8142(a)(2)(i) through (2)(iv) and, as a result, the Governing Body desires to amend Ordinance No. 1826 to specifically list the projects to be funded and the useful life of each of those projects herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, Ordinance No. 1826 is hereby amended to add a Section 8 thereof to read as follows:

Section 8 - Descriptions of the Projects and their Respective Estimated Useful Life.

The projects to be funded by the incurring of the debt and the respective estimated useful life of each are as follows:

- (a) The construction of baseball and softball playing fields and playground equipment, including facilities for disabled children and adults with the project having an estimated useful life of at least twenty (20) years
- (b) The construction of pool improvements to update aging equipment; to provide additional accessibility facilities and the installation of new activity equipment. The estimated useful life of these improvements and upgrades is at least twenty (20) years;
- (c) The installation of new drainage facilities, curbing, traffic signals, accessible crosswalks and bituminous wearing surface on the roads received as part of the State Turn-Back Program and will include remediation of bridge deficiencies identified during the annual bridge inspections completed by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation. The estimated useful life of all of the foregoing projects is at least twenty (20) years; and
- (d) The construction of accessible sidewalks and crosswalks along various streets throughout the City of DuBois, including, but not limited to, Main Street, DuBois Street, Beaver Drive and McCracken Run Road. The sidewalk project will also connect local businesses to the area's bus transportation system. The entire project is estimated to have a useful life of over twenty-five (25) years.

Section 9 - Ratification of all Other Portions of Ordinance No. 1826.

All other provisions of Ordinance No. 1826 are incorporated herein by reference and are reaffirmed the same as if the provisions were set forth at length herein.
