ORDINANCE NO: 1838

AN ORDINANCE

OF THE CITY OF DUBOIS AMENDING CHAPTER 27, PART IV, SECTION 400, SUBSECTION 1. OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF DUBOIS TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 1834 TO PERMIT PARKING ON ANY PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY IN THE CITY OF DUBOIS OR IN ANY AREA LOCATED BETWEEN THE CURB OR EDGE OF THE PAVEMENT OF THE ROADWAY OR ALLEY AND THE SIDEWALK WHICH IS NOT A PART OF A DESIGNATED DRIVEWAY ONLY UPON APPLICATION FOR AND RECEIPT OF A DRIVEWAY PERMIT AND A DRIVEWAY CONSTRUCTION PERMIT FROM THE CITY OF DUBOIS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the City of DuBois, in Council assembled, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same, as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 1 of Chapter 27, Part IV, Section 400 entitled General Regulations under the heading of off-street parking, loading and unloading shall be amended to add an exception to the prohibition against parking in public rights-of-way and shall hereafter read as follows:

§400. General Regulations.


1. Off-street parking, loading and unloading facilities shall be provided to lessen congestion in the streets. The facilities required herein shall be available throughout the hours of operation of the particular business or use for which such facilities are provided. As used herein, the term "parking space" includes either covered garage space or uncovered parking lot space or driveway space located off the public right-of-way. Parking shall not be permitted on the public rights-of-way within the City of DuBois or in any area located between the curb or edge of the pavement and the sidewalk which is not a part of a designated driveway, unless a driveway permit and a driveway construction permit is first sought and granted to the applicant by the City of DuBois in accordance with the City's requirements for the granting of such permits which requirements shall be imposed by the City Engineer for the purpose of insuring the safety of the public.

Section 2. All other portions of Chapter 27, Part IV are hereby reaffirmed and re-ratified insofar as the same are not in conflict herewith.


Section 3. All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances or Resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are herewith repealed.
