ORDINANCE NO. 1847

AN ORDINANCE

OF THE CITY OF DUBOIS AMENDING CHAPTER 425 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF DUBOIS TO AMEND SECTION 425-28 TO ADD THAT THE USE OF ENGINE AND COMPRESSION BRAKES (ALSO KNOWN AS "JAKE BRAKES") ON ANY STREET WITHIN THE CITY OF DUBOIS IS PROHIBITED.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the City of DuBois, in Council assembled, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 425, Section 425-28. Paragraph A. entitled "Truck traffic restricted on certain streets." Shall be amended to read as follows:

- A. The use of Engine and Compression brakes (also known as Jake Brakes) on any vehicle shall be prohibited on any streets within the City of DuBois. Moreover, it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle other than a passenger car on any of the following streets or parts of streets:

East DuBois Avenue	North Second Street and College Place
East Sheridan Avenue	North Fourth Street and East Logan Avenue
Kuntz Street	Williams Street and Hamor Street
Love Street	Spring Avenue and Patterson Avenue
Main Street (Added 7-23-2018 by Ord. No. 1835)	DuBois Street and Dixon Avenue
North Church Street	East Scribner Avenue to East Long Avenue
South Avenue	Main Street and the City Line
South Church Street	East Long Avenue and Olive Avenue
West Garfield Avenue	Juniata Street and Mahoning Street

Section 2. Chapter 425, Section 425-28. Paragraph B. is reaffirmed and re-ratified as follows:

- B. Provided that nothing in this section shall prohibit any person from driving an emergency vehicle on any of the above-listed streets or parts of streets or from driving on any of the above-listed streets or parts of streets a truck or other commercial vehicle making local deliveries to or pickups from premises located along that street or part of a street.


Section 3. Chapter 425, Section 425-28. Paragraph C. is reaffirmed and re-ratified as follows:


- C. Any person who violates any provision of this section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of up to \$500 and costs.

Section 4. All other portions of Chapter 425 are hereby reaffirmed and re-ratified insofar as the same are not in conflict herewith.

Section 5. All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances or Resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are herewith repealed.

Section 6. The within Ordinance shall become effective upon final enactment hereof.
